**10. MOTION- CONSTRUCTION OF HOME CRAFT TALENT CENTERS**

**AWARE THAT**, article 53 and 55 of the Kenya Constitution 2010 provided for the basic rights of children and youth. Where every child has a right to free and compulsory basic education and to be protected from abuse, neglect, harmful cultural practices, all forms of violence, inhuman treatment and punishment, and hazardous or exploitative labor;

**FURTHER AWARE THAT**, Article 55 of the Kenya Constitution 2010 emphasizes that the state shall take measures, including affirmative action programmes to ensure the youth access relevant education and training and access employment while providing opportunities to associate, be represented and participate in political, social, economic and other spheres of life;

**NOTING THAT**; Article 185 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides for the legislative authority of County Assemblies which empowers County Assemblies to make any laws that are necessary for, or incidental to, the effective performance of the functions and exercise of the powers of the County Government under the fourth schedule;

**CONCERNED THAT**; In Tharaka Nithi County the youth comprise of the highest population and there is no established talent center within the county and the youth who have nothing to spend their idle time on end up engaging in drugs and petty crime;

**FURTHER CONCERNED THAT**, failure to take adequate action of ensuring our youth are kept busy in constructive activities where their talents can be identified and nurtured while providing mentorship programs will result increase in crime and drug abuse;

**COGNIZANT THAT**, sub-section 9 of part 2 of the fourth schedule of the Kenya Constitution 2010 provides that County Governments are responsible for Pre-

primary education, village polytechnics, home craft centers and child care facilities;
